Scholarship Rules and Regulations

Eligibility:

1. Applicant must be currently enrolled or planning on enrolling in a course of study leading to a career in a construction related field.
2. Applicant must be accepted to or enrolled full time in a college, university, or technical trade school.
3. Applicants enrolling in a college or university must have a 3.00 or better grade point average to apply. Applicants enrolling in a technical trade school must have a 2.60 or better grade point average to apply.

 - b) Two letters of recommendation. The letters of recommendation should not come from a family member.
 - c) Official transcript of grades

Awards:

1. Scholarships are automatically renewed each year, for a maximum of four (4) years, given the student provides evidence of continued interest in a construction career and continued good standing in a college or technical trade program leading to a degree or career in a construction related field while maintaining at least a 3.00 GPA.
2. Applications will be reviewed and winners selected by the Grand Rapids Chapter #194 of the National Association of Women in Construction scholarship committee. The committee will evaluate the applicant's interest in construction, grades (if applicable), extra curricular activities, and employment experience.
3. All applicants selected will be subject to a personal interview with a representative of the scholarship committee and will be notified after the evaluation of all applications.
