# Scholarship Rules and Regulations

## Eligibility:

1. Applicant must be currently enrolled or planning on enrolling in a course of study leading to a career in a construction related field. Applicant must desire a career in a construction related field.
2. Applicant must be accepted to or enrolled in a college, university, or technical trade school.
3. Applicants enrolling in a college or university must have a 3.00 or better grade point average to apply. Applicants enrolling in a technical trade school must have a 2.60 or better grade point average to apply. Note: if an applicant has been out of school for a period of five years or more, this requirement is waived by the scholarship committee.

## Application Requirements:

1. The following must be submitted to the scholarship committee:
  - a) Application form
  - b) Two letters of recommendation. The letters of recommendation should not come from a family member.
  - c) Official transcript of grades. Note: if applicant has been out of school for a period of five years or more, an official transcript is not required. If applicant is currently enrolled in high school, college, university, or technical trade school whereby official transcripts are not released until program completion, unofficial transcripts will be accepted by the scholarship committee.

## Awards:

1. Scholarships are automatically renewed each year, for a maximum of four (4) years, given the student provides evidence of continued interest in a construction career and continued good standing in a college or technical trade program leading to a degree or career in a construction related field. For students enrolled in a college or university, maintaining at least a 3.00 GPA is required.
2. Applications will be reviewed and winners selected by the Grand Rapids Chapter #194 of the National Association of Women in Construction scholarship committee. The committee will evaluate the applicant's interest in construction, grades (if applicable), extra curricular activities, and employment experience.
3. All applicants selected will be subject to a personal interview with a representative of the scholarship committee and will be notified after the evaluation of all applications.
